## WATERWOOD MARINA DREDGING PROJECT

The Waterwood marina dredging was completed on November 24, 2019. New channel markers have been set marking the ingress and egress to and from the boat ramp. The new channel was dredged to a depth of approximately 4.5 feet. The old channel markers have been removed so hopefully if boaters follow the new markers the channel will stay clear. The dredge spoils are currently sitting on the open grass area in front of Bass Boat Village and will be spread as soon as the spoils dry out and then the area will be hydro-mulched. Many thanks go out to Steve Turchi for leading this project and to Tom Brick for overseeing the dredge spoils volume counts.
