

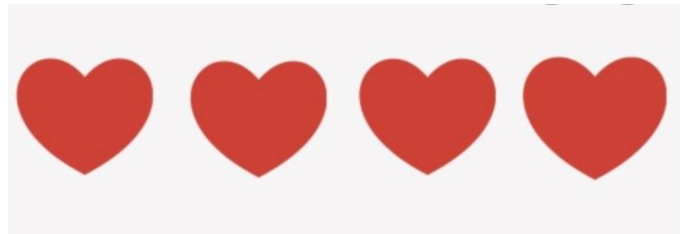

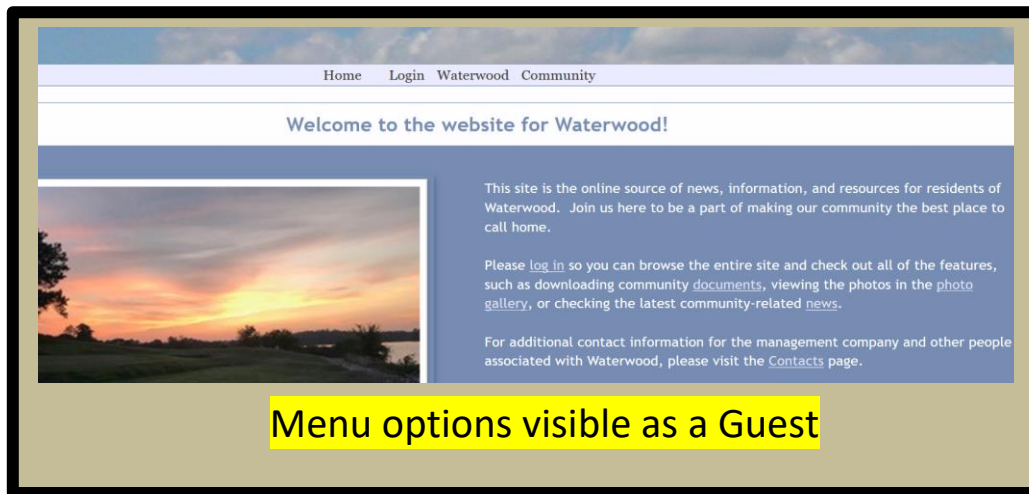
# We're Moving!

WIA has a new website [waterwoodwia.hospace.com](http://waterwoodwia.hospace.com).

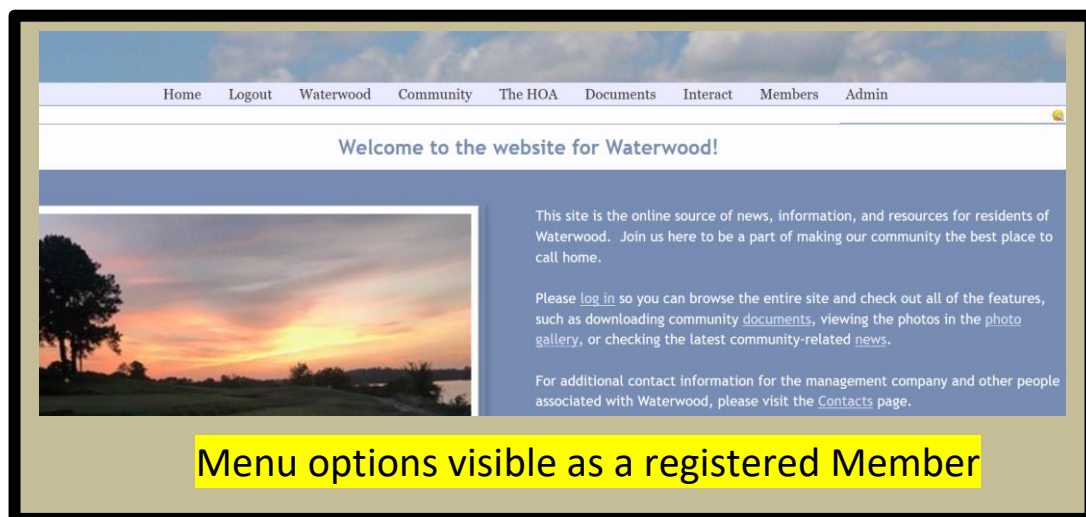
