WIA April Board Meeting Cancelled

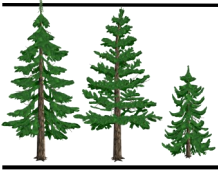

Maintenance Updates

In early March, repairs were done on Netawaka. Thank you to the neighbors near the site who allowed local traffic to drive on part of their front lawn during the repair process. This project saved our community \$1,000 by getting the job done in one concrete pour.

Our neighbors living on Edgewood Court, have been watching the road surface disintegrate in that area as new home construction continues. Construction bids are in the works to make needed repairs. Signs are posted directing construction vehicles to use one lane leaving the good lane for residents. This will buy us time until the heavy construction vehicle traffic is complete and proper road repairs can be done.

We have a considerable amount of road damage in new construction areas. Heavy vehicles such as dump/concrete trucks are taking a toll on our 50 year old roads. Waterwood has widespread infrastructure with over 2,100 building lots. These roads should be able to handle construction vehicles to build on empty lots. I've noticed some of the damaged roads with cul-de-sacs have insufficient road base.

Pools Creek Way and La Jolla are on the docket for repair as well. Be aware these roads may be repaired in phases. The board is in the process of establishing a five-year road plan. The issues over the past three weeks are forcing us to expedite our plan. It takes money, coordination with the County and MUD. Repair criteria starts with the most Hazardous/Safety concerns. I'll keep you posted on any developments.

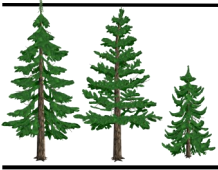

We'd also like to thank Gene Presley for the batting stand he built for the quilting group. It was desperately needed and greatly appreciated!

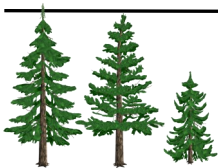

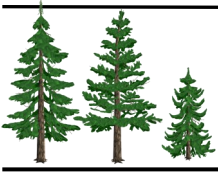

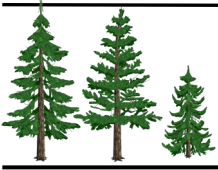
