

Craft Night in Waterwood!

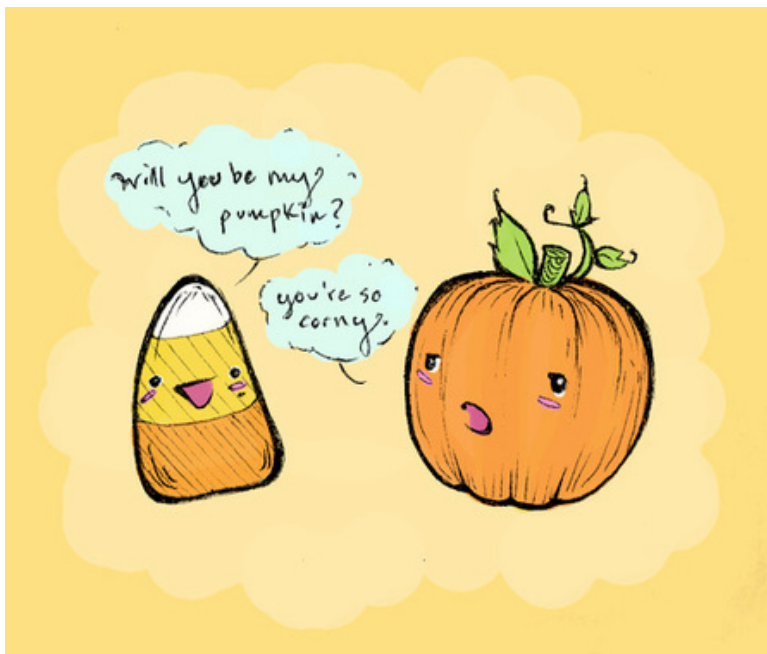

WNGRA - Waterwood National Golf & Recreation Association

Work continues on the course irrigation system. The primary sprinkler supply pump has been out for repair for a couple of Months and should be returned by the first week of October. A 10" lake water supply line, which has been leaking for over a year, has been repaired. Funding, the magnitude of the project, and a shortage of volunteers has impeded the repair for some time. The Board agreed to hire a local plumbing company to complete the project in one day. It is the Board's opinion that as our volunteer resources diminish, and quite honestly increase in age, we will be faced with hiring the required labor for projects from the outside more and more. Obviously, this will have an impact on our budget. Please consider this as you send your Monthly contributions in support of your ability to enjoy unlimited golf.

Regarding Board Positions and Leadership of the Organization, we have at least one qualified candidate/nominee for the position of President. We are still seeking nominees for the Treasurer position. If you've been acknowledged for your leadership in the various aspects of your career or volunteer organizations, and/or you're great at numbers and budgets, I ask that you consider stepping up to support WNGRA in 2025 and beyond. As outgoing President, I will commit to being available in a consultative role to the incoming Leadership Team, and will be happy to continue as Tournament Director for our major fundraiser in the Spring. If you're interested in Leading, please contact Nomination Chair, Ray Ramirez, or feel free to contact me directly for an exploratory conversation.

Lastly, while the Board decided not to have a major golf tournament in the Fall, some community members expressed a desire to have a simple, recreational golf tournament for community members and their guests. An informal poll showed sufficient interest, so the golf tournament committee and WNGRA agreed to coordinate the event. The date for the event is 11/23/24 at 9am. WNGRA will serve Burgers and Sodas afterwards. The format will be a 4-person scramble with a \$5 entry to fund a small prize pool. Bring your own cart, snacks, beverages, etc. No rental carts will be provided. For you sharks putting together a team of A players, I will have a special "twist" in the format/rules in order to equalize the field. (HaHa). PROGRESS SINCE THE LAST COLUMN:

WE HAVE FOUND A VOLUNTEER TO HANDLE THE CONTROLS (BY SMARTPHONE APP) THAT GOVERN THE WATERING OF THE ENTRANCES AT 190 AND 980. I CAN NOW DIVULGE HER NAME. DIANNE CHRESTOPOULOS (PRONOUNCED "DYE – ANNE") WILL LOOK AFTER THE ENTRANCES. SHE HAS ALREADY DONE A WRITTEN PLAN AND WILL DO A GREAT JOB. AS TO HER SUPERPOWER(S) REFERRED TO IN HER LAST COLUMN, I WILL DIRECT YOU TO HER HUSBAND ALEX.

FEDERAL DISASTER RESPONSE

I SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE APPLICATION FOR A LOAN FROM THE SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION [SBA]. THIS APPLICATION IS FOR THE POOL AND PAVILION COMPLEX, TO HELP PAY FOR THE DAMAGES DONE FROM THE MAY STORM DISASTER. LAST MONTH I TOLD YOU OF CONVERSATIONS I HAD WITH THE SBA REGIONAL COORDINATOR. AT THAT TIME I EXPECTED TO KNOW BY THIS NEWSLETTER WHETHER WE QUALIFY FOR A LOAN. I DO NOT KNOW THIS. THE SBA HAS YET TO CONTACT ME / US.

THE COUNTY-LED APPLICATION FOR FEMA FUNDS IS IN PLACE AS WELL. THESE FUNDS, IF GRANTED, WILL PAY FOR A LARGE PORTION OF THE WORK WIA DID TO REPAIR ROADS DAMAGE – PRIMARILY CULVERTS WASHOUTS – BACK IN MAY AND JUNE. RAY RAMIREZ AND I HAVE SPENT QUITE A LOT OF TIME THIS MONTH IN BACK-CHECKING AND AUDITING THE DOCUMENTS FROM THE DISASTER RELIEF EFFORT AND I HAVE TO THANK HIM FOR ALL THE HELP. WE ARE TRANSMITTING A BUNCH OF DOCUMENTS TO THE COUNTY AS PART OF THEIR APPLICATION; I'VE BEEN DOING THAT NON-STOP SINCE THURSDAY; A TOTAL OF 40-ODD PAGES SO FAR.

THE UPGRADE OF EVERY STREETLIGHT IN WATERWOOD TO THE SO-CALLED "DARK SKY RATED" LIGHTING IS NEARLY COMPLETE. AT LAST COUNT WE HAVE 11 – COUNT 'EM, ELEVEN – STREET LIGHTS THAT STILL NEED UPGRADING. THIS LIST OF 11 INVOLVES:

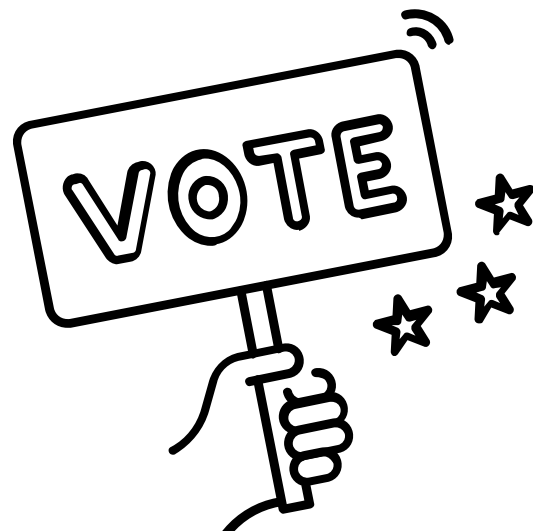
- FOUR (4) LIGHTS ON COUNTRY CLUB DRIVE, OF WHICH 2 ARE NEAR FAIRWAY ONE AND 2 ARE LOCATED ALONGSIDE THE OLD RESORT.
- THREE (3) LIGHTS AT THE TIP OF WATERWOOD PARKWAY NEAR BOB CHRISTIAN ROAD.
- TWO (2) LIGHTS AT THE ENTRANCE ON 190.
- ONE (THAT WOULD BE, LET'S SEE, 1) ON POLAND SPRINGS
- ONE (DITTO) ON THE PARKING LOT OF PINEY POINT.

ESD 2 (EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NUMBER 2)

THE PROPOSITION FOR ESD NO. 2 HAS BEEN PLACED ON THE NOV. 5TH BALLOT. 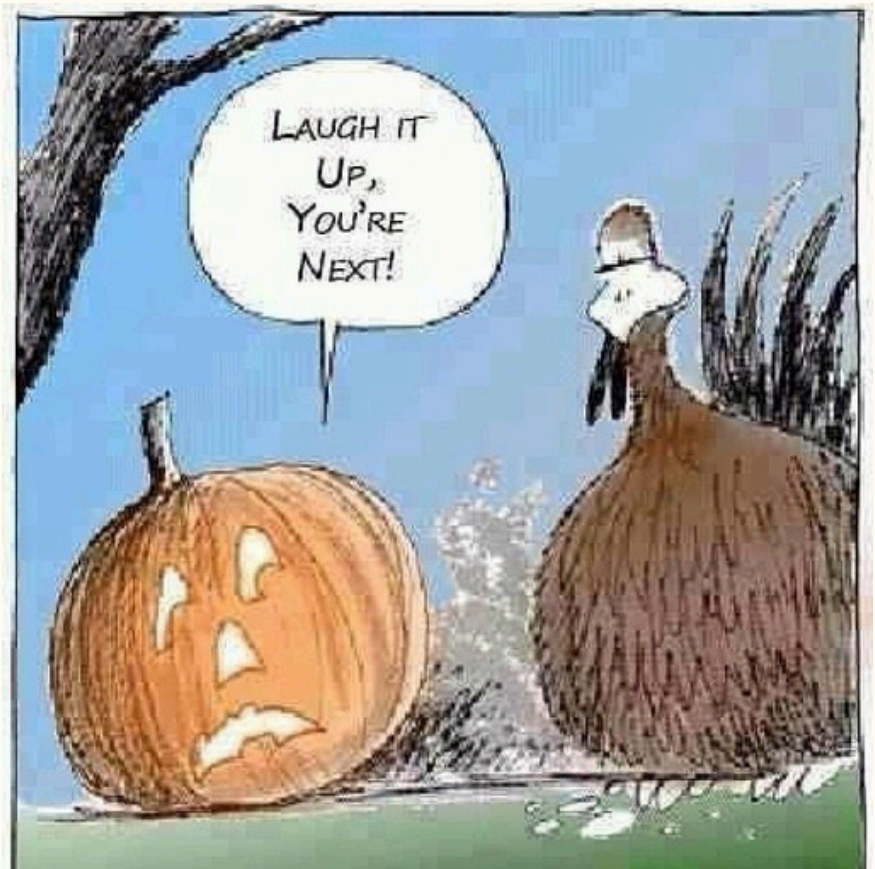
